English for Migrants

What is the Home Teacher Service?

We teach English to adults who have pre-purchased English language tuition through the New Zealand Immigration Service.

How does this service work?

Home teaching is one teacher with one student, usually in the student's home.

The Home Teacher Service will find you a teacher.

The lessons may be in your home or at a place that suits you.

Who can study?

We teach adults who have pre-purchased English language tuition. We cannot teach high school students.

How long can you study for?

You can study with a teacher as long as you have money available at the TEC (Tertiary Education Commission). They hold your money for you.

We recommend that your first contract is for a minimum of 26 hours. Then you can either stop your lessons, or continue if you have money left and a teacher is available.

Who teaches you?

All our teachers have a professional teaching qualification.

About your lessons

Your teacher will usually come to your home for the lesson.

Each lesson lasts from 1.5 to 2 hours.

Most students have a teacher for four hours each week.

Your own learning programme

You can decide with your teacher on the best time for lessons. Talk to your teacher about what you want to learn.

Your teacher will work with you to design language lessons to suit your needs and goals.

The teacher can help you with any aspect of English, including Kiwi expressions and grammar.

Home teaching can include practical tasks such as working towards getting a driver's licence or making appointments.

Your teacher uses resources from the local ESOL Home Tutors scheme, which include audiotapes, books, pictures and worksheets.

How much do lessons cost?

You paid for tuition when you paid the New Zealand Immigration Service, usually before coming to New Zealand.

The Home Teacher Service costs \$54.00 per hour (incl. GST). There is an administration fee of \$90.00 for the first contract and \$45.00 for a second (or any extra) contract.

Your teacher wants to help you learn English and understand life in New Zealand. Enjoy learning with us!

There is no extra charge for teaching material that the teacher provides, but if you want to study from special books you will need to pay for them.

Tuition starts on the day you meet your new teacher.

What happens when you enrol?

Our national office checks how much money the TEC holds for you.

The Home Teacher Service coordinator in your area contacts you.

The coordinator finds a teacher for you and introduces you to this teacher. Together you decide when and where you will study.

Remember: The tuition fee you paid to the New Zealand Immigration Service cannot be refunded.
