We work with migrants and refugees all over New Zealand. We help people to learn English and to understand more about life here.


**WHO CAN LEARN ENGLISH WITH US?**

Adults who have come to live in New Zealand and need help with English and settling into their community.

Some learners have studied English in their own country, and want to improve so they can find work and make friends.

For others, communicating in English is a new experience.

Learners would like to be able to speak more English so they can have more confidence. They want to do things on their own, reach their goals and be part of the community.



## WHO CAN TEACH ENGLISH WITH US?

Most of our programmes are taught by qualified, paid English language teachers.

Our well-known 'ESOL Home Tutor' service, however, is delivered by thousands of volunteers who have completed our volunteer training programme.

## IN SOME CENTRES

Some centres also offer the ESOL-Literacy Programme, special interest classes and other local programmes, such as job mentoring. Centres may also offer assistance with the English needed to get a driver's licence, access early childhood education or understand workplace English.
